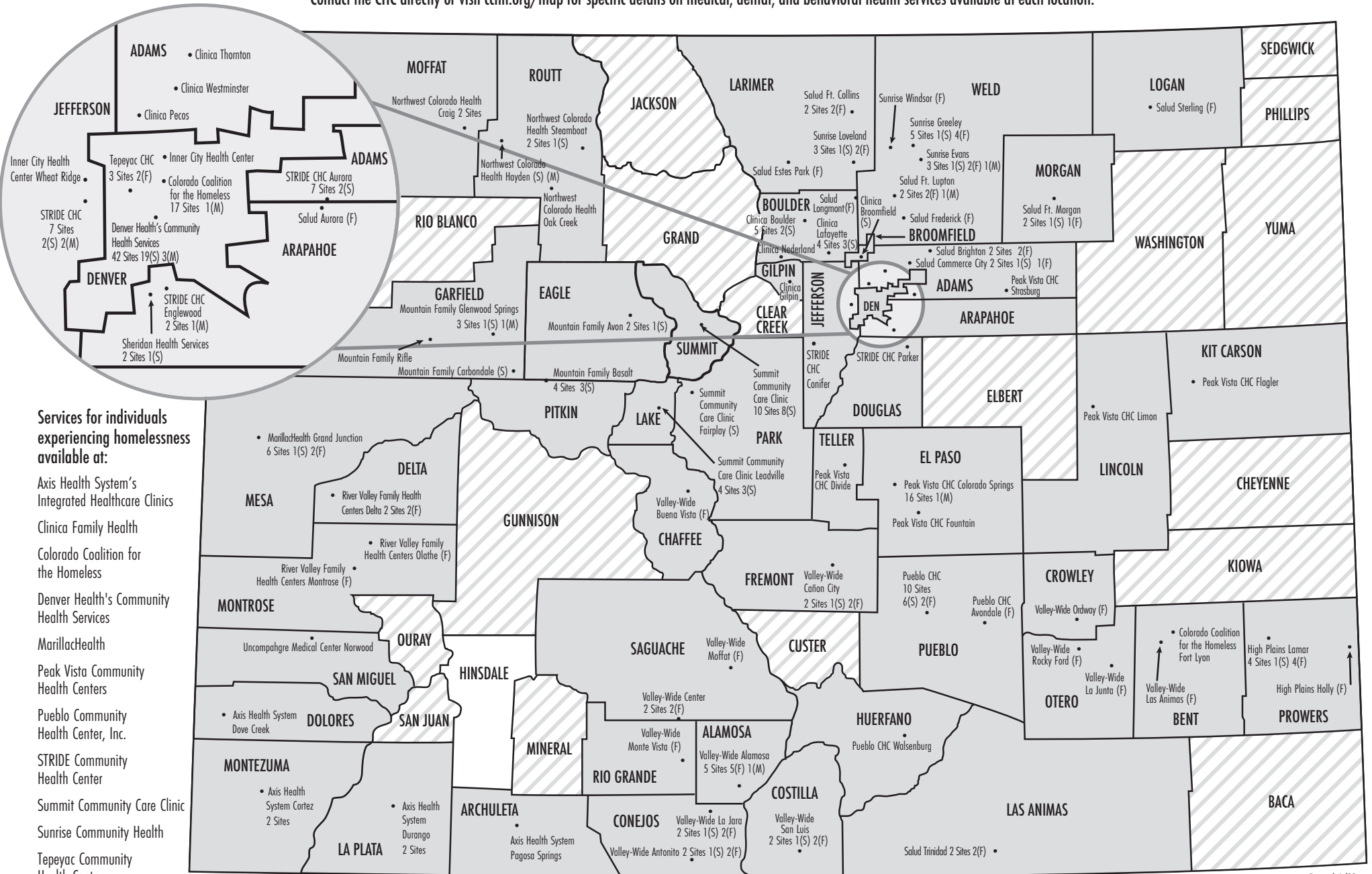


COLORADO'S COMMUNITY, FARMWORKER/MIGRANT, SCHOOL-BASED & HOMELESS HEALTH CENTERS
