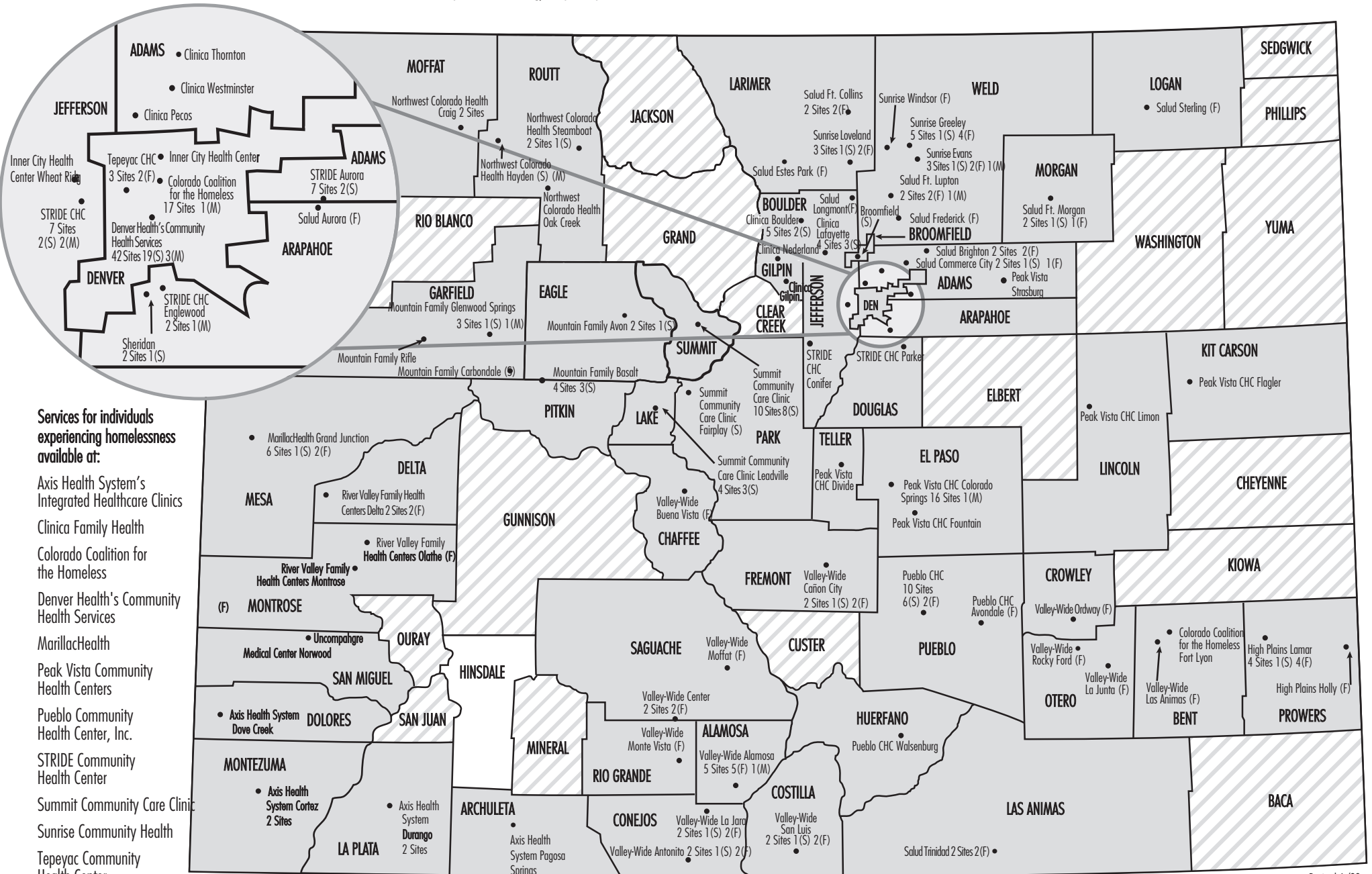


COLORADO'S COMMUNITY HEALTH CENTERS
